1. School & community programs update Mary Jeanne & Debe
  - Wrap up on school programs — final presentations to 1,716 students at Blue Ridge, grade 6-12; 235 kids at Holbrook, grades 5-6. Fall out from BRHS & JH sent at least a dozen kids to counseling or to question advisors about use and family issues. Greatest impact noted from Holbrook was interest in domestic violence and gangs in relation to drug abuse.
  - Recent community programs: Elder Abuse panel, 86 participants; Blue Ridge Mid School Showcase display, 55; Blue Ridge Safety Rodeo display, 400; Rainbow Treatment Center Open House, Whiteriver, 75; Show Low Days display, 1,500.
  - Upcoming program: July 10, 6 pm, St Mary's Church, Penrod Street, Pinetop — Faith-based community Crusade Against Drugs, panel presentation and interactive discussion. Organized with Catholic, Presbyterian, etc.
  - School and community programs pending: Northern Arizona Academy, Northland Therapy, Show Low students, Snowflake students.
  - Discussion from BRUSD wants follow up programs for parents in August.
