 - Locally designed and implemented by professional educators the program is supported through funding and in kind services by the County School Superintendent, BRUSD, Juvenile Probation, CASA, Pinetop-Lakeside Police Department, Cellular One and private donations.
 - The two-week pilot academy at BRUSD (July 16-26) for 15 youth aged 13 to 15 focuses on personalized instruction, active student involvement and experiences to develop goal setting skills, social and life skills, community service, oral and written communication, academic skill development, decision making/challenge exercises and drug awareness.
 - Completion ceremony for the 2007 Junior Leadership Academy, Thursday, July 26, 2007, 1 pm, Yellow Jacket Learning Center, BRUSD Campus
